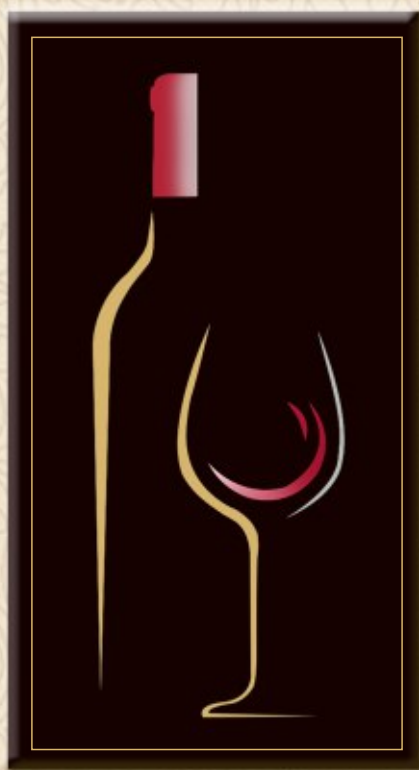

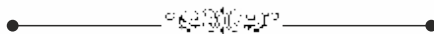


## *Preface*

The beverage book is a comprehensive source of information about wines, spirits and basic service equipment. The book takes the reader along a varied journey, including the history of Champagne, wine grapes, different style of spirits and beers

The tour is filled with detailed description of wine grape varieties, wine by glass options and side notes about different styles of spirits

It also offers an interesting and extensive selection of cocktails, from modern drinks made with vodka, juices and rum to traditional old fashioned standards like manhattans, martinis and negronis etc!!



## *History of Champagne*

Although the first wine-producing vineyards in Champagne appeared between the 3rd and 5th centuries AD, the events of the 17th century brought the beginning of Champagne as we know it today. The vine-growers of Champagne had learned how to stabilize their wines and keep them fresh for several years

### **The Region**

The Champagne region is located approximately 90 minutes northeast of Paris, France. In addition to the centuries-old method for making Champagne that originated in this region, its northern geographic position, harsh climate, chalky sub-soil, erratic sunshine, and limited harvest combine to create a one-of-a-kind terroir. That's why Champagne wines can only be produced in Champagne, France

### **The Grapes**

The process of Champagne making begins with the grapes. To be in accordance with the Champagne cultivation regulations, only three grape varieties are allowed in the production of Champagne

#### **Pinot Noir**

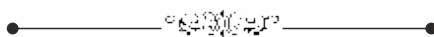
A black grape variety with white juice grown mainly on the slopes of the Mountain of Reims and Cote des Bar. It gives Champagnes their aromas of red fruits, as well as their strength and body

#### **Pinot Meuniere**

Another black grape variety with white juice. It is grown mainly in the Valley of Marne and is characterized by its suppleness and spiciness. It gives Champagnes their roundness and fragrance

#### **Chardonnay**

A white grape variety mostly planted in the Cote des Blancs. It provides the wines with their finesse as well as their floral aromas, and sometimes mineral overtones

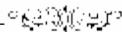


## White Wines

### Chardonnay

*Chardonnay is a green-skinned grape variety used to make white wine. It originated in the Burgundy wine region of Eastern France but is now grown wherever wine is produced. The grape itself is very neutral, with many of the flavors commonly associated with the grape being derived from such influences as terroir and oak. It is vinified in many different styles, from the lean crisply mineral wines of Chablis, France to New World wines with oak, and tropical fruit flavors.*

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## Sauvignon Blanc

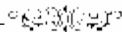
*Sauvignon blanc is a green-skinned grape variety that originates from the Bordeaux region of France. Depending on the climate, the flavor can range from aggressively grassy to sweetly tropical. In cooler climates, the grape has a tendency to produce wines with noticeable acidity and "green flavors" of grass, green bell peppers and nettles with some tropical fruit (such as passion fruit) and floral (such as elderflower) notes*

## Gewürztraminer

*Gewürztraminer is an aromatic wine grape variety, used in white wines, and performs best in cooler climates. The variety has high natural sugar and the wines are white and usually off-dry, with a flamboyant bouquet of lychees with aromas of roses, passion fruit and floral notes*

## Cortese

*Cortese is a white Italian wine grape variety predominantly grown in the southeastern regions of Piedmont in the provinces of Alessandria and Asti. It has an aromatic acidic bite, with complex bouquet of banana, apricot and fresh hay*

## Viognier

*Viognier is a white wine grape variety. It is the only permitted grape for the French wine Condrieu in the Rhone Valley. Outside of the Rhone, Viognier can be found in regions of North and South America as well as Australia and New Zealand. It has more natural aromatics that include notes of peach, pears, violets and minerality*

## Parellada

*Parellada is a white grape variety of Catalan origin specially grown in Catalonia. It presents a pale yellow colour with lemon skin tone and complex aroma with recall to white fruit maceration, evokes pineapple, banana and apple. It has a good balance between sweets and acidity, strong instructure and persistence with some fruity touch*

## Garganega

*Garganega is a variety of white Italian wine grape widely grown in the Veneto region of North East Italy, particularly in the provinces of Verona and Vicenza. The aromas and flavors are subtle and include lemony notes, pear, delicate almond nuttiness and nuances of white flowers*

*Cabernet Sauvignon is one of the world's most widely recognized red wine grape varieties. It is grown in nearly every major wine producing country among a diverse spectrum of climates. The great distinction of the wine it produces is that it has a very powerful and recognisable aroma of black currants wherever it is grown and if matured in newish oak, can smell of cedar, cigar boxes and sometimes tobacco*

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## Shiraz

*Shiraz is a dark-skinned grape variety grown throughout the world and used primarily to produce red wine, tending to produce medium to full-bodied wines with medium-plus to high levels of tannins and flavors of blackberry, mint and black pepper notes*

*Sangiovese is a red Italian wine grape variety. Sangiovese often has a flavor profile of sour red cherries with earthy aromas and tea leaf notes. Wines made from Sangiovese usually have medium-plus tannins and high acidity*

## Corvina

*Corvina is an Italian wine grape variety that is sometimes also referred to as Corvina Veronese. The grapes naturally high acidity can make the wine somewhat tart with a slight, bitter almond note. The finish is sometimes marked with sour-cherry notes*

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## Merlot

*Merlot is a dark blue-colored wine grape variety, that is used as both a blending grape and for varietal wines. Merlot involves harvesting Merlot earlier to maintain acidity and producing more medium-bodied wines with moderate alcohol levels that have fresh, red fruit flavors (raspberries & strawberries) and potentially leafy vegetable notes*

## Zinfandel

*Zinfandel is a variety of black-skinned wine grape. Red berry fruit flavors like raspberry predominate in wines from cooler areas, whereas blackberry, anise and pepper notes are more common in wines made in warmer areas*

## Nebbiolo

*Nebbiolo, is a red Italian wine grape variety predominantly associated with the Piedmont region. The wines take on a characteristic brick orange hue at the rim of the glass and mature to reveal other aromas and flavors such as violets, tar, wild herbs, cherries, raspberries, truffles, tobacco, and prunes*

A liqueur is an alcoholic beverage made from a distilled spirit that has been flavoured with fruit, cream, herbs, spices, flowers or nuts and bottled with added sugar or other sweetener. Liqueurs are typically quite sweet; they are usually not aged for long after the ingredients are mixed but may have resting periods during their production to allow flavours to mature aged in oak barrels

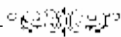

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# Glossary

ABV	: Alcohol by volume; a measure of how much alcohol is in an alcoholic beverage
Ale	: A dark, malted beverage
Amaretto	: An Italian liqueur with a sweet almond flavor
Beer	: An alcoholic beverage made from yeast-fermented cereal grains
Bourbon	: An American whiskey distilled from corn mash, malt, and rye
Brandy	: A distilled spirit made from grapes, typically aged in oak barrels
Brut	: The lowest level of sweetness of sparkling wines
Cachaca	: A Brazilian spirit made from fermented sugarcane
Campari	: An Italian bitters with a distinctive red color
Cassis	: A dark red black current Liqueur
Cava	: Spanish sparkling wine
Champagne	: Sparkling wine from the Champagne region of France
Chaser	: A drink that follows a shot of alcohol
Cognac	: Brandy produced around the town of Cognac in western France.VS means the cognac has been matured in oak barrels for at least two years.VSOP and Vieux indicate four years; and Extra or XO indicate 6-10 years of aging
Curacao	: Liqueurs produced from the bitter peel of the Seville orange. It comes in many colors, although blue is very common
Dash	: The smallest ingredient amount measured
Digestive	: A drink consumed after a meal to aid in digestion
Drambuie	: A Scottish whisky and honey liqueur
Dry	: A term applied to drinks and spirits that are differentiated by degree of sweetness, such as sparkling wines and gin."Medium dry" is sweeter than "dry", while "extra dry" is less sweet than "dry" Eau de vie Colorless fruit brandy
Float	: An ingredient carefully poured so that it floats on top of a drink Fortified wine Wine with a spirit added to it
Frangelico	: An Italian liqueur made from hazelnut
Galliano	: A gold-colored Italian liqueur flavored with herbs
Gin	: A clear spirit flavored with juniper berries
Grand Marnier	: An orange liqueur
Grappa	: Clear Italian brandy distilled from the remains of grapes used in wine production
Jagermeister	: A German herbal liqueur
lager	: A beer that is light in color and body
liqueur	: A sweetened spirit that has flavor, aroma and colour added
Mixed drink	: A drink where alcohol is combined with a mixer
Mixer	: Juices, sodas and other non-alcoholic liquids mixed with spirits
Mist	: Poured over crushed iced
Muddle	: To crush up ingredients with a special tool called a muddler. This is done for drinks such as the Mojito - where the muddling process extracts essential oils and flavours (from the mint leaves in case of the Mojito)
Pastis	: A French anise flavored liqueur served as an aperitif
Quinine	: A bitter compound which flavors tonic water; a malaria preventative
